



## Day 1 (12-05-2026)

### Morning session

We will be waiting for you (until 09:30 am) at entrance **Metiusgracht (A)** to guide you to the Pieter van Foreestzaal. If you are late then please follow the instructions below.

### Pieter van Foreestzaal (015) **PF** : 09:30 – 12:15 (followed by lunch)

The best place to park your car is at **Singelgarage, P1, P2, or P5**. Enter the hospital at the entrance **Metiusgracht**. From there, the auditorium is straight ahead. Go through the staff restaurant and you will find the Pieter van Foreestzaal behind the restaurant.

### Afternoon session

The afternoon sessions will take place at the Noordwest Academie in location Westerlicht (**B**). This location is within walking distance of the hospital.

## Day 2 (13-05-2026)

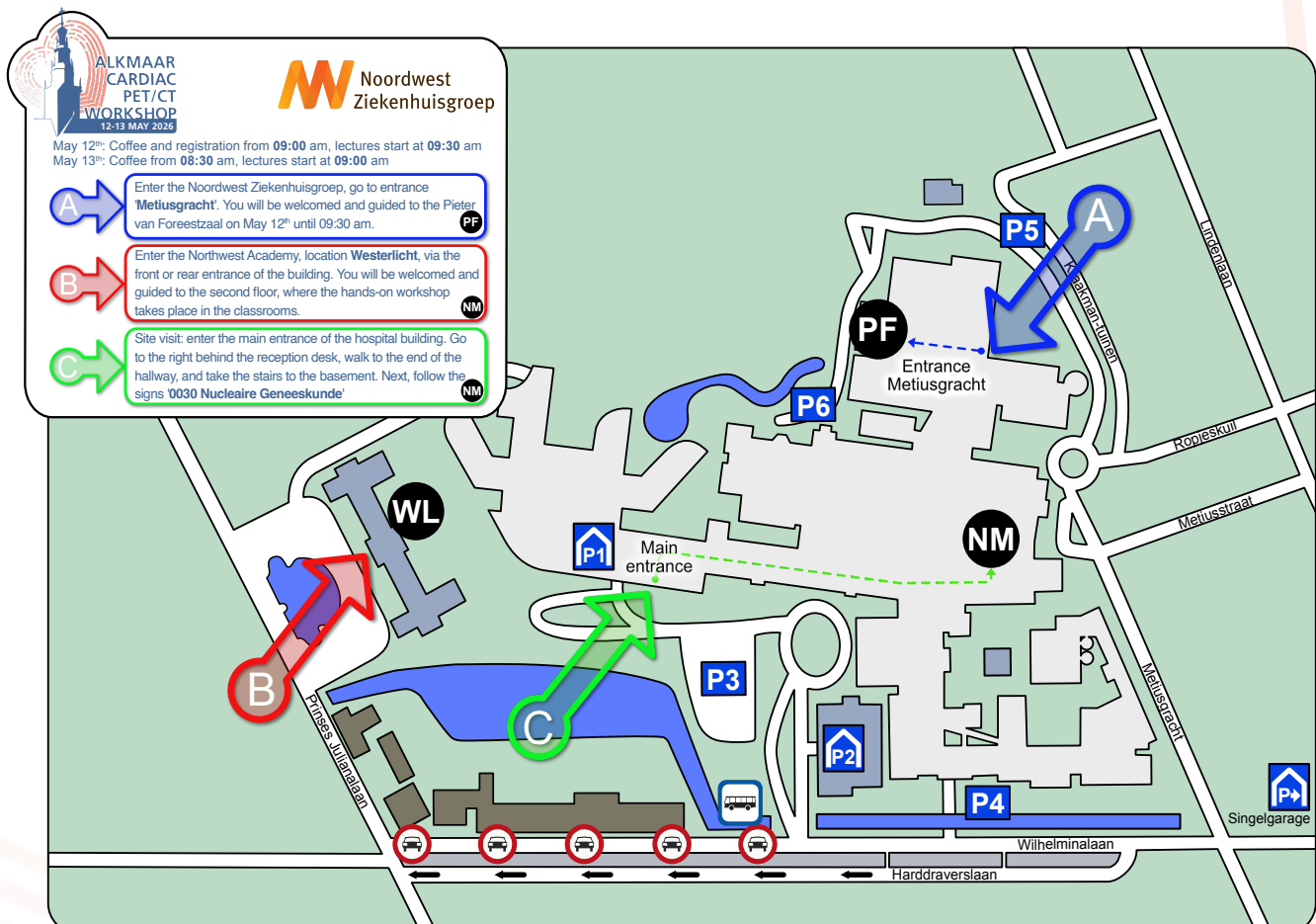
### Morning session
